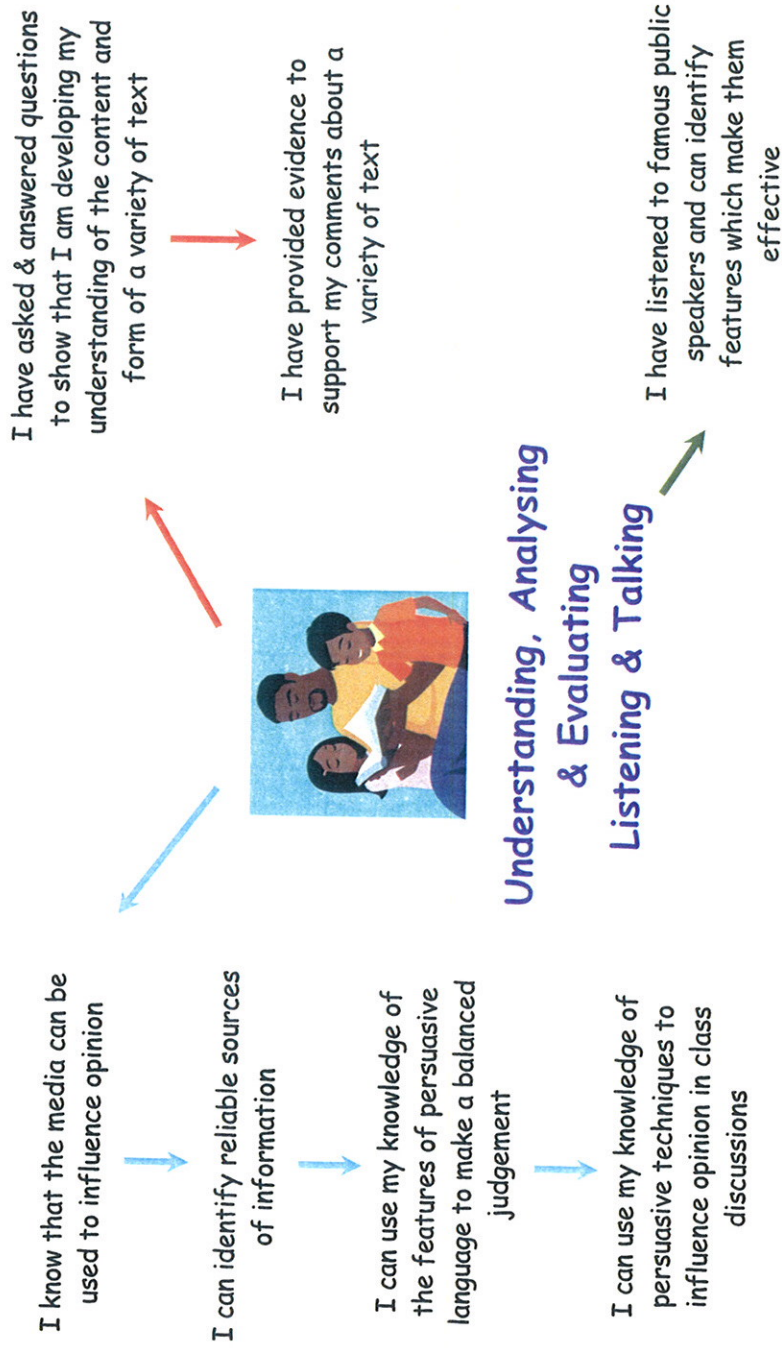


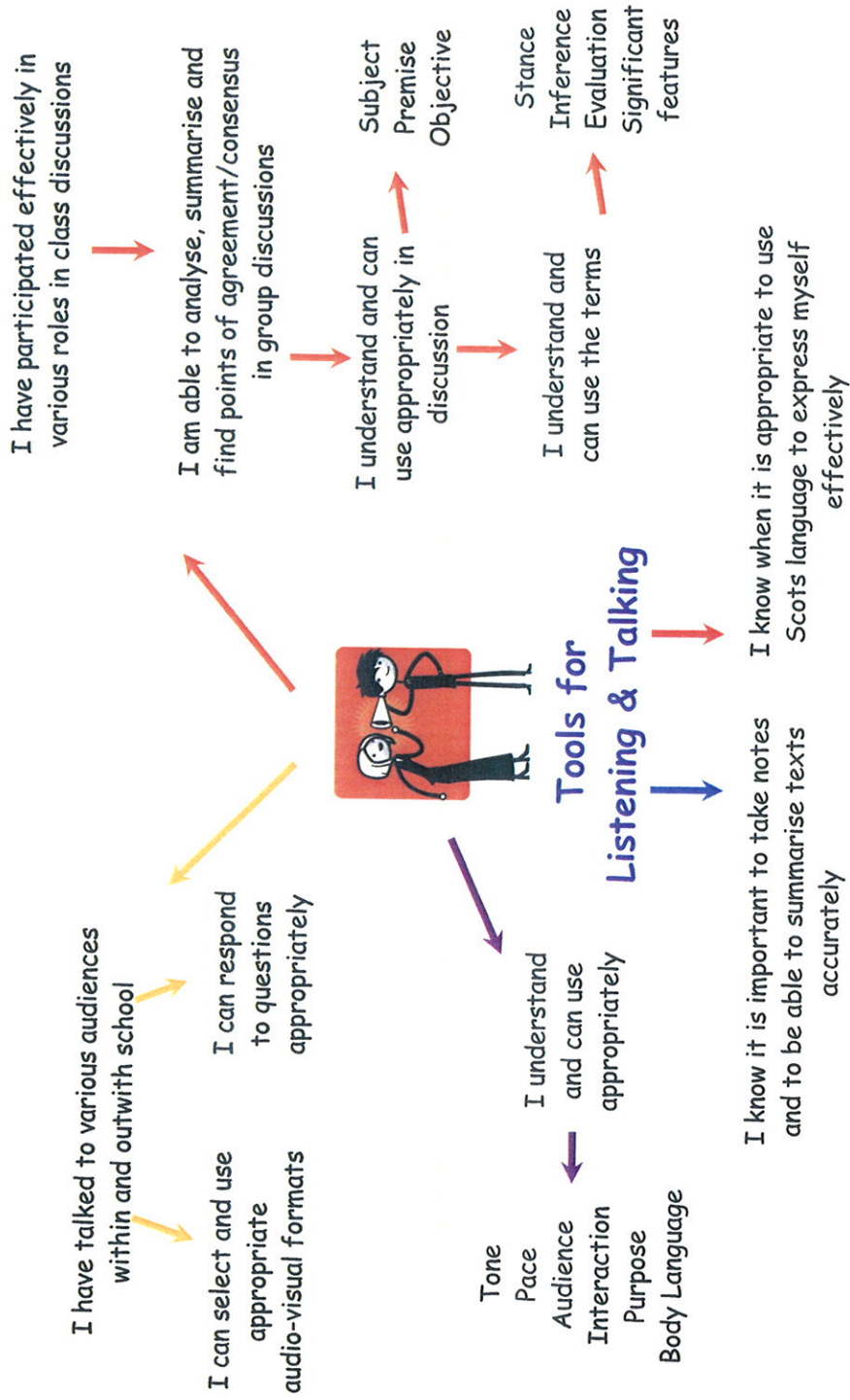


I can show my understanding of what I listen to or watch by commenting, with evidence, on the content and form of short and extended texts. LIT 307G

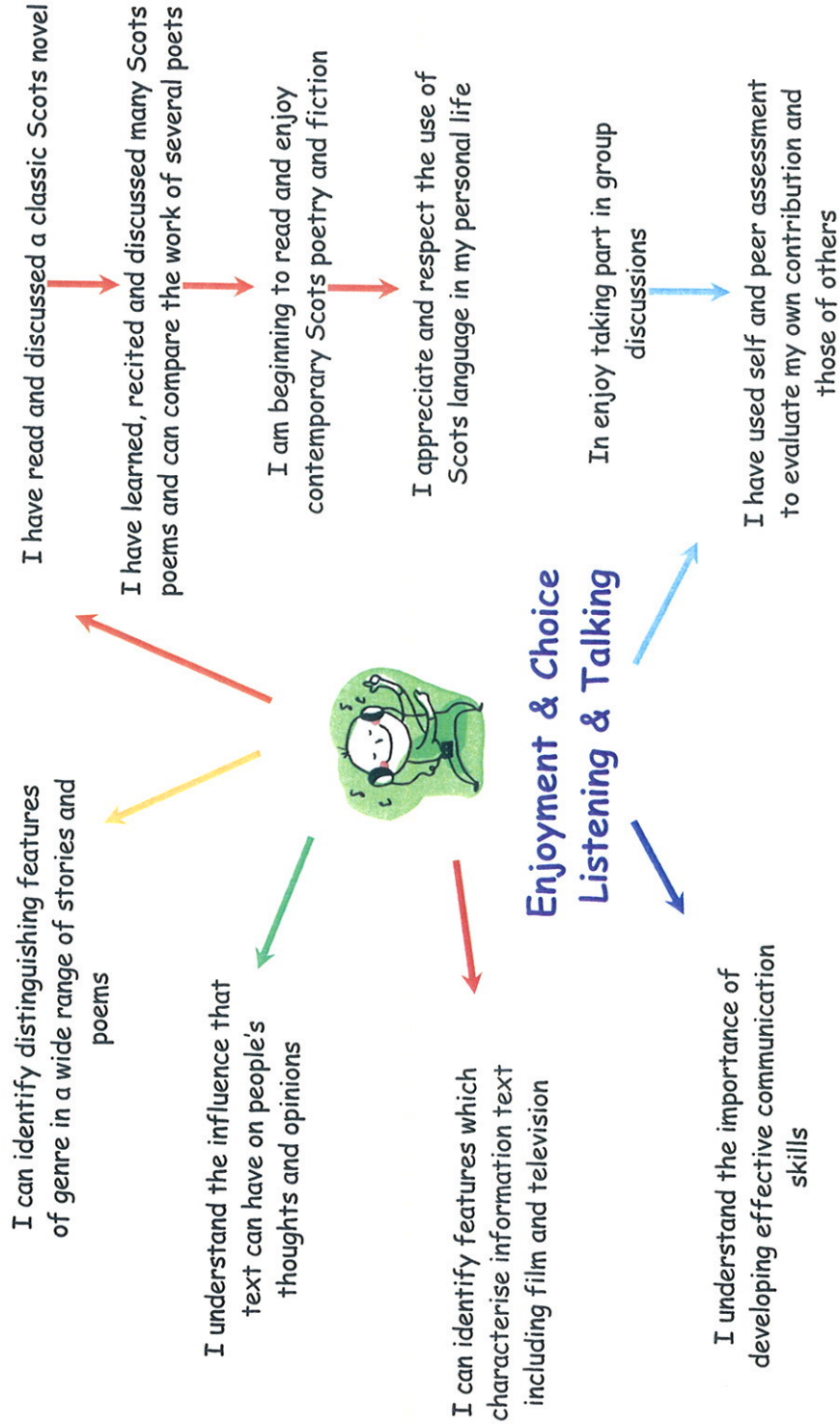
