

<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Numeracy</u></p> <p>Choose any 2 bricks from your group's numeracy home learning wall. These activities will reinforce the practical tasks being taught and covered in class. Choose an activity and if you can, colour and date the brick when covered. You can use your jotter to write down any work or descriptions of what you have done.</p> <p>Circles: 5A Wall Triangles: 3A Wall</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Sumdog</u></p> <p>Log in to your account and take part in your group's maths challenge. Log in details are provided in your pack.</p> <p>Download the Sumdog app for free or visit: www.sumdog.com</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Time</u></p> <p>Look around the house and write, draw or take a photo where you see time devices at home, e.g. alarm clock, cooker timer. Your learning can be emailed or recorded in your jotter.</p> <p>Talk together about how the devices are used.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Money</u></p> <p>Look at either a catalogue or an online shopping page. Decide on a budget</p> <p>Circles: £10.00-£20.00 Triangles: £1.00-£5.00</p> <p>What items or combinations of items can you buy? Record your findings in your jotter.</p>
<p><u>Language</u></p> <p>Accelerated reading</p> <p>Log in to your account and take a quiz on a book you have read. You can also take a quiz on a book that has been read to you.</p> <p>Reading Wise</p> <p>Log in to your account and play. Aim to spend 20 minutes on each ReadingWise session that you do.</p>	<p><u>Language</u></p> <p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Practise your group's spelling words in your jotter following the look, cover, say and check method you are familiar with. Ask an adult to test you at the end of the week. Choose a spelling activity from the spelling menu.</p> <p>Oak: ie sound for ee Cherry: ea sound saying ee Willow: CVCC words</p>	<p><u>Language</u></p> <p><u>Writing</u></p> <p>Watch a film or your favourite television show.</p> <p>Write a review in your jotter. Think about the plot, the characters, your opinion and whether you would recommend it.</p> <p>Remember capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.</p>	<p><u>Language</u></p> <p><u>Talking and listening</u></p> <p>Play a board game. Read aloud the rules before beginning and explain them to the group.</p> <p>Commentate on the game. Interview the players, ask them about what they are doing and keep sharing the scores. Announce the winner to the group, ask them how they feel.</p>
<p><u>IDL</u></p> <p><u>STEM: Invention design</u></p> <p>Create the new invention you designed in class. You can use junk modelling, Lego or any items found around your house. If you can, take a picture and email it or draw the finished invention in your jotter.</p>	<p><u>IDL</u></p> <p><u>P.E: Joe Wicks</u></p> <p>Keep active and have fun indoors with a 30 minute P.E lesson every morning at 09:00am.</p> <p>Go to The Body Coach TV: https://www.youtube.com/thebodycoachtv</p>	<p><u>IDL</u></p> <p><u>HWB: Hygiene and Safety</u></p> <p>Have a look around the kitchen to see if you can identify areas where you need to be careful.</p> <p>Discuss what foods can be stored in the cupboards and what foods need to be stored in the fridge.</p>	<p><u>IDL</u></p> <p><u>Art:</u></p> <p>Get creative using paint, chalks, pens or colouring pencils to draw what you can see from a window at home. Focus on colour and line. Think back to when we painted fresh flowers, perspective is very important. This task will need lots of concentration and focus. Complete the task in your jotter or email a picture of your finished masterpiece!</p>
