Can you identify the word, make it with your sound cards and then write the word correctly?  Links to each game are back on the class website page.  For 3 letter words use 'CVC Guess the Word'. Challenge yourself with 4 letter words and double sounds by using 'CVCC Guess the Word'.	Join in with the Joe Wicks workout every morning this week. Click this link at 9am Mon-Fri and exercise with millions of other children around the world!	Practise finding hidden numbers using your number line. Ask an adult to cover up numbers and see if you can figure out what numbers are before, between and after.  Next Step: if someone writes a number line with some numbers missing, can you fill the missing numbers in?	Draw an egg shape on your whiteboard. Can you decorate the egg using different patterns? You could draw these with the whiteboard pen, or place craft stickers, pompoms or other small objects on top to create your patterns.
Create an Easter word- search on this website. Practise your typing skills by entering the words below by yourself. Then play the game and see how many words you can find! EGG, EASTER, HUNT, ROLL, SPRING, BUNNY, LAMB, HOP	Make an Easter card for a friend or family member. If you need to send it by post, help someone at home with addressing the envelope.	Find out information about a bear of your choice. Write 1 of 2 facts in your green book and draw a picture of the bear.  Go back to our class website page to access 'Bear Fact Ideas' - a list of possible websites and videos for you to use.	Boil an egg and decorate it for Easter. Have an egg rolling competition with someone at home. Can you measure how far the egg rolls each time? Use objects to measure eg. How many tins long? How many footsteps long? How many DVDs long?	This week's tricky words are 'be' and 'we'. Please ask an adult to write them on your word wall and then practise reading, writing and using these in conversation.
