

Bear Fact Ideas

Using the internet is only one way of finding out information! Maybe a family member knows a fact about a bear, or you have an animal fact book at home? If you have an Amazon Alexa, try asking it a question about the bear you've chosen.

When helping your child write out the facts, try to use simple language. For example: if your child has heard the fact:

Insects, nuts, berries, sap, branches and roots are a big part of a bear's diet.

Talk about how we can write this using simple language like:

Some bears eat plants and berries.

It's important for children to use the sounds they know, so encourage them to sound out the words they are writing, even if the spelling isn't quite correct. They will feel extra proud if they have tried to write it themselves! Don't be afraid to help your child to form the letters too if needed \bigcirc
