Use your letter sheet and sing the alphabet song pointing to each letter as you sing it. Continue to practise writing your letters correctly.



Read a story. Draw a picture and write a sentence about what happened at the beginning, the middle and at

the end of this story.



Please learn the next 5 key words from your key word sheet.



Use your 100 number square. Ask a family member to shout out a number and then you tell them the number that comes before and the number that comes after that number.
e.g. the number 62 would be 61 and 63.

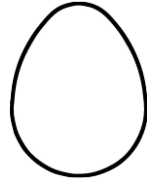
Use the blank number square to write the numbers 1-100.

Think of a number below 10. Add 10, then add 10 to that number, add 10 again... keep going up to 100.
e.g. 3, 13, 23, 33, 43....93





Roll a dice, say what the double of that number is. Write the double sums into your jotter.
e.g. $1+1=2$, $5+5=10$



Draw a large Easter egg shape and decorate it with shape and colour patterns.
e.g. red square, red square, green triangle, yellow circle, red square, red square, green triangle, yellow circle etc.

Design an Easter bonnet. Describe it using 5 adjectives.
