Write down as many as you can in your book. I can think of 5. Can you think of more than that?</p>  <p>Please try to learn the next five key words from your list.</p>	<p>Watch a movie with your family and name as many of the characters as you can. Also discuss where your movie is set. Would you like to go there? Discuss if it would be fun or not.</p> 
<p>Revise saying the days of the week.</p> <p>Make a diary. Write a sentence about what you do each day and draw a picture.</p> 	<p>Use your 100 number square and ask a family member to shout out a number and then you must try to write the three numbers before and after that number. Try with lots of different numbers.</p> 	<p>Write down any four numbers between 1 and 100. Write them down and then put them in order starting with the smallest or try starting with the largest.</p>	 <p>Write down as many sums as you can where the answer is 10. Your sums can be add or take away.</p>	<p>Using the numbers 1-50 try to make your own dot to dot picture. Ask one of your family members to join the dots to see if it works.</p>
