

Write sentences using these words.</p>	<p><u>Language</u></p> <p><u>Talking and listening</u></p> <p>Alphabet chain: Choose a category and take turns naming an item that fits the category following the sequence of letters in the alphabet. The first person chooses a word starting with a, the second person a word beginning with b, the third person with c. The category can be anything at all – animals, countries, names, superpowers, etc.</p>

Follow your own ideas and interests. You can do this on your own or with your family. You can play inside or outside. Play helps you to develop important skills whilst keeping active.</p> <p>Choose some <a href="#">loose parts</a> that you might not have considered playing with before. Be curious and imaginative. Remember to record and share all the fun you have had.</p>	<p><u>IDL</u></p> <p><u>STEM (choose 1)</u></p> <p><a href="#">Technology</a> Complete challenge 1,2 and 3. Record your answers in your jotter. Email any pictures of your app icon design.</p> <p><a href="#">Science</a> Complete challenge 1 and 2. Record and explain your guesses in your jotter.
