If you have any paint at home this would be another fun activity to try</p>	<p><u>PE and Movement</u> Try out some Circus Skills at home Also here is a Yoga option -Pedro the Penguin goes to the Funfair</p>	<p><u>Independent Writing</u> The Penguin wants to fly. Can you think of an animal you know and imagine something new it might like to try? See if you can write a sentence about this and draw a funny picture</p>	<p><u>Tricky Words</u> This week's tricky words are 'his' and 'her'. Please ask an adult to write them on your word wall and then practise reading, writing and using them in conversation.</p>
<p><u>Wellbeing</u> Keeping in touch is important. This week see if you can learn your name, address and your home contact number. See if you can say it and write it down.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> <u>What goes up must come down!!</u> That's gravity. Have a look at these videos to find out how this works first second and an experiment to try at home</p>	<p><u>Technology</u> Make a string telephone and try it out with someone in your family And/Or Make a spoon catapult You can use ordinary sticks if you don't have lollipop sticks.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Here is another Activity linked to the story. This time we are looking at fast and slow movement.</p>	<p><u>Visit the Zoo</u> Let's see what the penguins are up to on the Edinburgh Zoo Live Webcam. Aren't they amazing? There are some other animals you can watch too.</p>
