<p><u>Maths - Ongoing</u> Challenge set on Sumdog for everyone focused on your maths group's previous learning. I'll keep an eye on your progress.</p> <p><u>Maths Calendars</u> Continue with your maths calendars for May.</p>	<p><u>Maths - Multiplication Pairs</u> Make a matching game with flash cards. Write out 20 multiplication sums on individual pieces of paper/card and the answers on another 20. Sit all the cards face down, mix the questions and answers up and play a matching, memory game! Rectangles/Circles focus on the 6,7,8,9 times tables. Triangles focus on 3,4,5 times tables. Squares try it with 2 digit multiplication.</p>	<p><u>Maths- SAMSON Sheets</u> Triangles should complete the time challenge sheet starting 247-129</p> <p>Circles and Rectangles should complete the division $85 \div 7$.</p> <p>Squares - work through your booklet independently.</p>	<p><u>Maths Riddles</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Using only addition, how can you add eight 8's to get the number 1,000?2. The ages of a father and son add up to 66. The father's age is the son's age reversed.
