So this week, grab a notebook!</p> <p>What and how you write is entirely up to you! Here are a few ideas of how to fill the pages;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • write a list – shopping, ideas for activities, places you would love to go when you can, a ‘wish list’ ... • write a review – a book, a movie, a meal, a toy... • draw and label a picture – a new layout for your bedroom, an obstacle course... • write a letter – to a friend, a family member, a celebrity you admire... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • doodle, decorate or design... • share your favourite recipe... • create a scrap book – stick in your favourite memories, pictures and write about why they are special to you... 	<p><u>Spelling</u></p> <p>Complete page 7 of your booklet.</p> <p>Can you create a wordsearch using your words? Ask a family member to complete it.</p> <p>Remember to write in your words in the boxes first, then use random letters to fill in the rest.</p>
<p><u>Coding</u></p> <p>Coding is the method of giving instructions to a computer to perform a specific task.</p> <p>On Purple Mash, there are different games you can play where you need to set the instructions for the computer.</p> <p>This week, I have set some coding ‘2Do’ games to try.</p> <p>The instructions for the games appear before the game begins.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Have a go at the ‘Birds in your Garden’ reading comprehension and other activities on the P3 page.</p> <p>Can you record the birds you see either in your garden, from your window or on your daily walk?</p> <p>You could create a simple graph, take photographs if you can or draw a picture.</p> <p>Also, have a go at creating a Bird Feeder to attract different birds.</p>	<p><u>PE</u></p> <p>Follow this link to a Cosmic Kids video.</p> <p>It is about Nelson the Pigeon – did you see a pigeon when you completed the Bird Watch activity?</p>	<p><u>Maths – Money</u></p> <p>This week, let’s try to create our own amounts with money.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Have a go at the activities on Education City and this game. • Have a look at the activities for your group on the P3 page. <p><u>My Top Tips</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • You will need to use your adding skills. You are adding coins together to make an amount and to find a total. • Remember the strategies we use in class for adding – start with the larger number and break down the smaller number into tens and ones – 50p + 33p is the same as 50p + 10p + 10p + 10p + 3p. • Try to count on - ‘If I have 46p, how much more do I need to make 52p?’ Count up to 50p first, then to 52p. • Try to think of the amount in terms of 10s and 1s. 55p is the same as five tens and five ones. Think of £1.22 as 122p. • Always try to start with the biggest coin you can without going over the total. You can always take coins away if you have too much. • Remember, there is no such thing as a 4p or a 6p etc, you will need to think carefully about how to make certain amounts. 	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Have a go at the Word Problem Challenge Cards below.
