

Teams Meet

This week, we have scheduled a Teams Meets as an opportunity for the children to say “hello” to each other.

It has been set up nationally so that the staff members can be both heard and seen on the screen, but that the children’s video is not visible to others. Their microphone, when switched on, will allow them to be heard by others in the group.

This will be a very informal chat whereby the children will be able to have a little chat and tell their friends about what they have been up to over the last few weeks or share any news that they wish to. If your child is feeling nervous about participating, please tell them not to worry, simply log in and have a listen. They can turn their microphone off and just enjoy listening to their friends. There is absolutely no obligation to join in, they will be able to type a little message instead, should they wish, and we will be able to see it.

We are so looking forward to saying “hello” to the children and to enable them to see us for some familiarity from the school environment they are used to.
