



## Castle Douglas Primary - Home Learning - Primary 2. Week 1

<p>Please use the Education City Link above and click on classwork to look at our spelling sounds this week.</p> <p>I have added the words we are using this week into the groups below.</p> <p>Perhaps you could revise your spelling words by writing them out in different colours like a rainbow.</p> 	<p>We were learning about how to write sentences last term. We were looking at when to use full stops and capital letters. Try to include your name or the names of places in some of your sentences.</p> 	<p>At this time of year we usually think about something we would like to improve about ourselves. Can you think of anything you would like to get better at? Please use the star sheet below or make one of your own to decide what you would like to improve.</p> 	<p>Choose a book you really like and read it with a member of your family. Discuss with them what part of the book you liked the best. Try to make three drawings about the story. The first drawing could be about the beginning of the story, the second drawing should be about the middle and the third should be about the end. If you would like to perhaps you could include a sentence describing each part.</p> 	<p>When we were talking about what we wanted to learn this term some people wanted to learn about day and night. Please watch this short clip and try the quiz. The link is written below the grid.</p> <p>Try to draw a picture of your house and garden on a clear night with all the stars and the moon in the sky.</p>

Count how many words you can write in one minute.

Which task did you do best in?

Did you find a minute longer or shorter than you thought?



We are going to revise symmetry today by copying patterns using the website Topmarks. Try all the games with pictures, shapes and patterns. I will put the address below the grid.

When you have tried the activities please draw a symmetrical picture of your own.



Try counting aloud within 100. You could count backwards or forwards. You could start at any number and finish at a chosen number too.




Roll a dice and write down the number. Do it again and write the number next to the last one. What is that number?

Roll a 3 and then a 4 to make 34 or 43. See how many different numbers you can make.

During January we usually try to learn to say aloud a Scots poem. We try to learn the poem and we put actions in it too. I thought we could try to say Nessie the Loch Ness Monster by J.K. Annand or if you would like to choose a poem of your own that will be fine too. Perhaps you could record yourself saying your poem and send it to me. You do not have to learn the whole poem this week. Please just try to do what you can. I thought we could perhaps draw Nessie and decorate her with tartan colouring. You could choose three of your favourite colours and make up a tartan of your own like the ones below.
