This term we are looking at the Bible and we will be starting off by identifying different types of books. Watch this clip to help identify the different types.

Now look at the worksheet "[What's in it?](#)" and see if you can work out which book is which, write the titles as your answer. On the back draw the front cover of your favourite book and write which type of book it is. A Holy book tells you about a religion, we will find out more about this next week. If you don't have a printer, just match the books on the screen and follow the other instructions on a sheet of paper.

This week we are thinking about honesty, this is when you tell the truth about something. It is important to be honest especially if you have done something wrong. Have you heard the story of Pinocchio? He had a friend called Jiminy Cricket who told him when he did something wrong, this is what your conscience does and why you might sometimes feel guilty, if you tell the truth, it helps you to feel much better.
