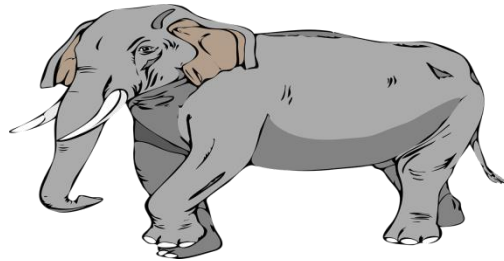


This is Miss Newall's favourite animal. I have written a story about my favourite animal to remind you how to write a describing story.
