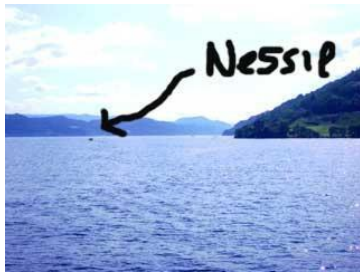
Your task is to use your research skills to take yourself on a virtual tour around Scotland.

### IDL - Scottish Artist Study

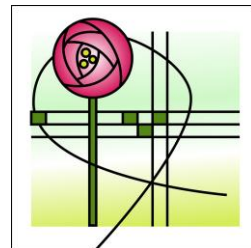
We are going to learn a little about the work of a famous Scottish artist - Charles Rennie Mackintosh.
