Covid-19 Update

As you know, the number of Covid-19 cases has risen dramatically in Dumfries and Galloway over the last few weeks. At CDPS we continue to take all precautions to ensure that everyone is safe. If your child or someone in your household is displaying any of the following symptoms then please isolate and book a PCR test:

- 1. Loss or change in sense of taste or smell
- 2. High temperature/fever
- 3. New continuous cough

If the PCR test result is positive then let the school know. Test and Protect will contact you and tell you what the next steps are. They will also identify close contacts and they will be advised to isolate and to go for a PCR test. We will follow advice from Public Health Scotland and will distribute a 'warn and inform' letter to our school community as advised. This may mean that everyone receives a letter or it may only be distributed to one class.

I know it can be worrying to hear of a positive case, but at CDPS we have rigorous systems in place to keep us all safe.

Our Parent Teacher Association helps organise social (in non-COVID times) and fundraising activities during the session. Meetings are informal and we would like as many Parents / Carers to join in. It is a good way to meet people in the school and we are always looking for new, fun ideas for children and parents that may also raise some funds.
