<p>Songs are a great way to practise times tables, by giving you a tune to remember. These can be found on YouTube.</p>	<p>Make a set of flashcards for each times table. Read the question, and then check to see if you are right!</p>	<p>A good starting point for online tables practise is Sumdog. Another good website to help learn tables is Top Marks.</p>
<p>Splat!</p> <p>Use flashcards with answers written on them and ask someone to ask quick fire questions. Splat the correct answer with your hand.</p>	<p>Pass the Ball</p> <p>Pass a ball between yourself and a family member and ask each other quick fire questions.</p>	<p>Recite</p> <p>Say your times tables in the car, on a walk, or even at bedtime.</p>
<p>Timed Tables</p> <p>Set a timer and see how quicky you can write out your times tables. Keep trying and try to beat your best time!</p>	<p>Quickfire Questions</p> <p>Ask someone to ask you quickfire questions and see how many you can get right in a row.</p>	<p>Multiplication Flower</p> <p>Make a flower like this one and stick it on your wall. It will help you remember your times tables <i>and</i> division.</p>
