Language

We would love you to make a family tree and bring it in to class when you start on August. Get someone to help you draw or stick a tree onto a sheet of paper, then find some photos of all the important people in your family to stick on it. Please also write the special names you call each of them.

Fine/ Gross Motor Skills

Jar - Bits and Pieces

Gather together a jar and a variety of different objects e..g. bricks, buttons, hair clasps, sweeties, beads etc. You'll also need some things to use for picking them up such as a clothes peg, tweezers etc.

Your task is to use these to pick up the different items and put them carefully into the jar- see which things are harder or easier to do!! This is really good for making your fingers strong and ready for writing!

Maths

How about downloading the Bee-Bot app - it is free and is a fun activity to start learning how to make things move in different directions! We will do more of this in Primary One.

Science

You could maybe plant a flower seed in a pot or in your garden and see how much it grows over the summer holidays - remember it will need to have sun. light and water to help it grow. A sunflower is lovely.

Independent Skills

Keep practising your self-help skills such as dressing and undressing yourself, and going to the toilet all by yourself. Remember to wash your hands carefully afterwards every time! You can sing the Happy Birthday song to help you remember how long it takes!
