



Collin Primary operates an open door policy, and if there is any concern over homework or indeed any other aspect of your child's learning, please come into school and speak to us.



# Collin Primary Homework Policy

Our Vision, Aims and Values clearly state that we wish to:  
Develop effective partnerships between home, school, other agencies and the community in order to raise levels of participation and achievement.



Homework is one way that Parents/Carers at home can help their children to raise attainment and achievement. Homework expands upon what is done during the day in the classroom. It reinforces learning and encourages the children to use the skills and knowledge they have been learning throughout the week. Homework allows Parents/Carers to have a deeper understanding of what their child is learning about.

- Homework for P1/2 Pupils would be outlined annually to Parents.
- Homework is given on a Tuesday and should be returned to school on the following Monday. This allows families flexibility to complete homework at a time which suits. Also this will give the teacher a chance to mark and give appropriate feedback and for new homework to be issued.
- Reading will be heard every day for P1/2, 3/4 times a week for P3-4 and 2 times a week for P5-7.
- Homework will be stuck into the homework jotter. Normally homework will consist of Literacy and Numeracy tasks.
- Please ask for any resource you may require to complete the homework tasks.

We ask that Parents/Carers provide a quiet space for children to complete their homework. We acknowledge that this is not always possible and we offer **Homework Club on a Monday lunchtime** where every child can complete their homework and receive assistance from the class teacher and access any resources required.

**Please bring your homework folder to school every day so that reading can be heard as necessary!**
