# What is a foodbank?

- A foodbank is a charity that gives food you bring in, to family's or people who are unfortunate and **don't have money to buy food.**



# Why are food banks important?

- ◉ **Foodbanks are important** because more and more people are becoming homeless, or in a bad condition to work.



# how many foodbanks are there in the UK and who made the first ever foodbank?

- ◉ In the UK there are about **2,000 food banks!** Britain foodbanks were first opened in 2000. A man called John Van Hengel in 1967 created the first ever foodbank in Arizona.



# What is happening right now because of foodbanks?

- ◉ It is very sad but in the whole world over **8 MILLION PEOPLE** have been unable to get nutritious food. Many people in the UK have raised awareness of the food banks so now a lot more people are opening and donating to foodbanks so now all the people who are unfortunate can get more food



# Why do people use foodbanks?

- People may have medical conditions and cant work so they cant earn money to buy food, or people may not work and not get benefit money to buy nice food for there family or themselves.

# LETS WORK TOGETHER AND CHANGE ALL THIS!


- ◉ Volunteering and getting oppertunities to get **free food**






