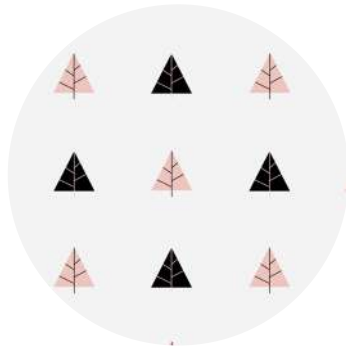

**Universal Credit:
 Advance Recovery Reduction**



From October 2019, the maximum rate at which deductions can be made from Universal Credit will be reduced from 40% to 30% of the standard allowance of Universal Credit.

Gas safety advice



If you can smell gas or suspect you have a leak, If you think you've got a gas leak in your home or can smell gas anywhere outside, leave the house or area and call the National Gas Emergency Service immediately on 0800 111 999.

Only use a mobile phone outside, well away from the leak.

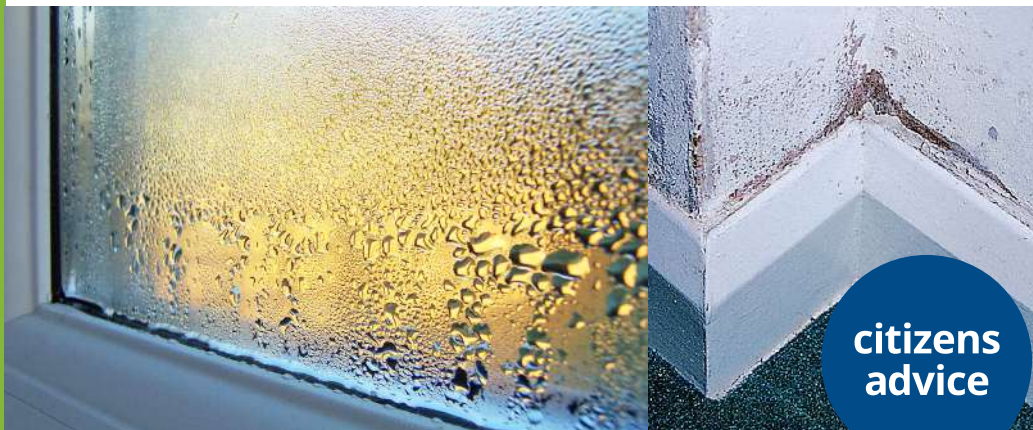
Heat Proofing Tips

Stick on draft excluder strips can be attached to the bottom of doors that may face the outside. Also, Draught excluding tape can be put around the inside of your door/window frame. Amazon has loads of options available and does not cost a lot of money.

Dealing with damp



It's not always easy to work out if your landlord is responsible for resolving problems with damp. This is because it can be difficult to find the exact cause of damp without the help of a surveyor, unless, it's obvious, such as a leaking roof. However, if you have issues of damp it is always worth raising this with your housing association or landlord.

Check what kind of damp you have

Damp is a common problem which many tenants experience when renting accommodation. There are several types of damp:

- **Rising damp, which happens when moisture travels up from the ground through the masonry to the height of about one metre.**
- **Penetrating damp, which happens when water penetrates into the fabric of a building from outside to inside, for example, because of a leaking downpipe.**
- **Construction damp, where damp is caused by a problem in how the property was designed.**
- **Condensation damp, which generally happens when a property can't deal with normal levels of water vapour because of a lack of insulation, ventilation or heating, or a combination of all of these things.**

Taking action on damp

If you've reported problems with damp to your landlord and they haven't done anything about it, there is action you can take.

• **Contacting the local authority**

Tenants in private rented accommodation and tenants of housing associations could contact the local authority's Environmental Health department.

• **Taking court action**

If your landlord's responsible for dealing with damp and they don't do it, it's possible to take them to court. Taking court action can be costly and time consuming and you should only take it as a last resort.

Vaping Cannabis Oils

There have been lots of reports recently about people getting seriously ill and even dying after vaping in North America.

Not all the facts are known yet, but it looks like it's mainly young people using e-cigarettes to vape cannabis oils who have been affected. very little is known about the health impact of vaping cannabis oils. What is known is that there is no entirely safe way to use any drug and vaping home-made or illicit e-liquids or adding substances to vapes is risky.

Once there is evidence on the precise cause of the recent cases in North America we will update our cannabis information if necessary.

Yellow Pills causing kidney problems

It has come to our attention that there have been several admissions to DGRI secondary to the ingestion of illegal drugs which have adversely affected the kidney health of those involved. Although all cases are doing well, this side effect was thought to be unusual enough for the receiving medics to notify Public Health. Further discussion with 2/3 cases has confirmed a history of ingestion of multiple "yellow tablets". Intelligence from the police has confirmed that such tablets are doing the rounds locally. Although to date there is no proven cause and effect, the evidence is anecdotal at best, I do feel that it is worthwhile to share this information with you and your peers. - Acetaminophen
- Amphetamines
- Caffeine
- Cocaine
- Fentanyl
- Lead
- Methaqualone
- Noscapine
- Phenobarbital
- Procaine
- Quinine
- Scopolamine
- Strychnine
- Thallium

EU Citizens Support

Our specialist helpline service for EU citizens resident in Scotland is called EU Citizens Support and is funded by the Scottish Government. This service is free and impartial and is designed to help EU citizens and their families with issues and concerns about the EU Settlement Scheme. It is available across Scotland through our network of local Citizens Advice bureaux – find your local bureau.

This service is for EU citizens who would like to apply for settled status but have extra needs. For example, you may:

- **have difficulty accessing an Android mobile phone**
- **have limited access to the internet**
- **find it difficult to get the evidence you need to apply**
- **be at greater risk due to personal circumstances**
- **have specific immigration or residency issues.**

You can get free, confidential and impartial advice from our website, in person at your local bureau and on the phone. Our EU Citizens Support service has a national helpline 0800 916 9847 and is open Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm.
