




<p>Numeracy</p> <p>We are going continue to practice our subtraction skills in particular writing a number sentence and working mentally. Log on to Education City. Complete task 'No Parking'. Next try the activities given on Task Board 12 posted below the grid. You can play games more than once. 😊</p> <p>Complete the worksheets 'Subtraction 1' and 'Subtraction 2' below the grid. Try to count backwards in your head. There is also a numberline at the top if needed.</p> <p>Try this fun game! Choose Level 1 'subtracting 1' then 'relaxed mode' and 'slow fruit'. Next try Level 2 subtracting 2. Look at the numberline for the sum then splat the matching number sentence. Fruit Splat!</p>	<p>Numeracy</p> <p>We are learning to add and subtract within 10. Let's combine our skills and practice 1 more and 1 less mentally. Log on to Education City. Complete task 'Fruit Frenzy'. Next have a go at doing the 'Timed Worksheets' below the grid. You could do 1 column a day. If you don't have a printer ask an adult to write out the sums beforehand. Decide if you want to give yourself 1 or 2 minutes. Try not to use your fingers. Pick and choose what interests you. 😊</p>	<p>Topic – Freezing and Melting</p> <p>We are learning that <i>freezing</i> is when a liquid turns into a solid like water turns to ice. <i>Melting</i> happens when a solid turns into a liquid like a chunk of chocolate melts if it is heated up!! Click to watch - BBC iplayer - Freezing and melting Notice what happens to the butter and the ice-cream - they turn into a liquid.</p> <p>Task: Make an ice ornament. There are ideas posted on the sheet perhaps you might gather things to freeze from your garden or a walk up the woods. You may have to use your freezer depending on the weather!
