Connect Parent/Carer Survey Report: Prescribing the Minimum Number of Learning Hours Many thanks to the 243 parents and carers from 31 local authorities who responded to our survey

for the Scottish Government's consultation on *Prescribing the Minimum Number of Learning Hours in Schools*. You can read our submission to the consultation and the background documents here. The majority of respondents agreed with the proposals to prescribe learning hours, but there was much less confidence in the proposals to make exceptions to the prescribed hours for local authorities to use. Here, a lack of clarity, fears that children and young people could be negatively impacted by reduced learning hours and the potential for local authorities to use 'loopholes' to save money were concerns.

Young people have taken a lead role in designing a new website for the region's Child Adolescent Mental Health Service (CAMHS).

The new site at https://dghscp.co.uk/camhs/ has been co-designed by the website working group including young people, parents and carers and staff.

Erin (aged 16) one of the young people involved within the website working group said: "We tried to make the website as colourful and as nice as possible, to try to bring the mood up a bit. It's important for us young people to be involved in building the service, we know what it's like to have accessed the service before or be accessing it now, so we can feed back our own experiences."

"Different people needed different information so we had sections for professionals, parents and carers, and young people. There's also a section on the website that lets you meet the practitioners, so you have a rough idea of who you're meeting. When I first started going to CAMHS I didn't know who I would be meeting, and it made me really nervous. If you are in crisis and you go to the website there's a button you can press that says 'I am in crisis', that tells you what you can do and you can submit an online self-referral too"

We would really appreciate if you are able to promote and share our new CAMHS website amongst your colleagues, children, young people and families who you are all working alongside. Alison Telfer, CAMHS Participation Lead
