Parents are responsible for the safety and behaviour of their own children on the evening. Entry to the event will be through the main reception to the school hall or through the gate leading from the pathway nearest to P1 and P1/2 lines in the playground.

A small donation would be welcomed to support this event.



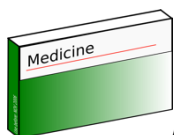
Christmas Post - School

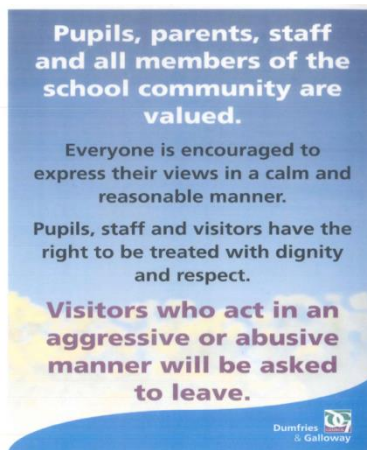
