


Dear Parent/Carer,

Your child's regular attendance at school is extremely important. Our agreed target of attendance here in Dalbeattie Primary School is 95% in line with the local authority stretch aim for attendance. Attendance levels have continued to decline over the past few years.

The illustration below indicates the expected levels of attendance at school and the correlation between the number of days missed and attendance percentages for each child.

Arriving late to school consistently also has an impact on your child's education.



Attendance data is analysed every month by school staff and we will be in touch to discuss any concerns as they arise. We understand that personal circumstances can result in poor attendance or regular late coming for your child and are sympathetic to this.
