# Health and Wellbeing

In P.E this term we will be focusing on fitness and improving our stamina.

In Health, we are focussing on friendships. How friendships are formed and that likes/ dislikes, special qualities and needs can influence relationships. Pupils understand positive things about friendship and relationships but know who to talk to if something worries them.

We will also be doing weekly circle time sessions where this term.

### Social Studies / Science



Our topic this term is Toys! We are going to be learning all about different types of toys, toys across the decades, how toys move, how toys are made and much more.

Here are some of the key questions from the pupils!

How do toys fly? How do they make some toys really soft? How do they make toys?

In Science this term we are looking at forces. We will be investigating how force can make an object change speed, direction and shape. We will sort toys into those that needs to be pushed or pulled and much more.

# Literacu

Primary One are focusing on initial sounds and we are following the Jolly Phonics programme. They are learning the names of the letters and the sounds that they make. Groups will also be looking at blending letters together to make CVC words.

Primary Two are continuing to look at diagraphs and we are trying to spell these and common words independently. In Grammar, we will be looking at Alphabetical order, common nouns and proper nouns.

In writing, we are going to be using the work we have been developing by Stephen Graham and looking at descriptions. We will be linking this to our topic and describing different toys.

In listening and talking we are using "Listen Up" where they have to listen to the instructions and complete the activity. We are also listening to stories and talking about what parts of the story we like.

# Reading / Homework



Primary Two are continuing to use the Dandelion readers for most pupils and we are finding that these are definitely encouraging the children and allowing them to gain confidence.

Homework information will be sent home in the pupils homework diary/bag and if you require any further information regarding this then please just ask.
