## LITERACY

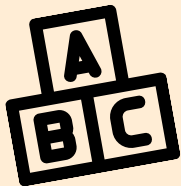
**Comprehension Skills** – inferring, retrieving and vocabulary skills, linked to class novel.

**Art** – We will be exploring a variety of ways in which we can create a portrait

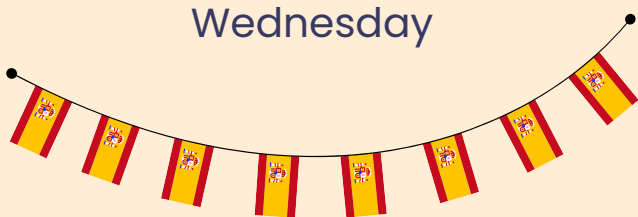
**Music** – We have completed our Ram Tam block with Emily Smith.
