P5-7 Golfing Sessions

The pupils from the P5-7 class will be undertaking 3 weeks of golfing tuition with Gladys McClymont on behalf of Active Schools. This will commence during school from **Monday 12th May** weekly until **Monday 26th May** between 9.00 – 10.00am. Thereafter, on the morning of **16th June** the pupils have been invited to participate in a Golf Tournament at Thornhill Golf Course. Further details on this will follow.

P4-7 - Electric Explorers

On the morning of **Tuesday 13th May**, our P4-7 pupils will participate in an Electric Explorers interactive workshop that explores electricity; what it is and how it is produced. The class will go on a journey as Electric Scientists to discover how we can produce electricity from the movement of our bodies. Pupils will explore the principles of electricity using circuits, flowing electrons, magnets and capacitors. As a final challenge, the children will work in small groups to assemble their own generator and produce electricity from their own movement.

P1-3 - Our Changing Climate

On the afternoon of **Tuesday 13th May**, our P1-3 pupils will participate in 'Our Changing Climate' which is an interactive show exploring our planet's climates and how they're changing. The characters Sunbeam and Raindrop lead pupils on an interactive journey to discover what climates are, what causes changes in global temperature and what we can do to help our planet. Using interactive experiments, games, demonstrations and storytelling, 'Our Changing Climate' takes a gentle approach to a big subject and helps start classroom conversations around the environment and how everyone can help.
