

New Learning Folders

Following consultation with pupils, parents and staff, we are delighted to launch our new learning folders!

Parent Guidance

- Learning folders will share the 'Latest and Best' evidence of your child's learning.
- Learning folders will be organised into 3 sections - Wider Achievements (including Reflection Log), Pupil Choice, Teacher Choice.
- The Pupil Section will contain 3 pieces of work your child has selected as a piece of work they are proud of and would like to share- *Every time a new piece of work is selected to be added, the oldest piece of work will be removed from that section.*
- The Teacher Section will contain 3 pieces of work selected and agreed by your child and their teacher together. *Every time a new piece of work is selected to be added, the oldest piece of work will be removed from that section.*
- Folders will come home prior to PPT Talk Time appointments– The work in the folder can help you to decide aspects of your child's learning you may like to discuss at your appointment.



New Learning Folders

Pupil Voice—You said

- 3 pieces of work chosen by pupils
- More pupil choice

- More pupil selection
- Send them home before PPT Talk Time appointment
- Learning folders are too bulky, work falls out.
- Folders need to be more consistent

- Folders will be sent home prior to PPT Talk Time appointments
- Smaller folder being used with only 3 sections and a lot less content
- Clear guidelines created to ensure this
