What we have been learning

We had a wonderful end to 2023 in nursery. Our Christmas songs celebration in the nursery garden was enjoyed by all! This involved the children choosing songs and then voting on their favorites. Learning new songs and then building their confidence to sing them in front of a very large audience.

Investigations were led by the children into the changing states of water with freezing and thawing. Clay pinch pots were made by the children for presents which prompted discussions about how the clay changed from soft and squidgy when making the pot shape to hard when it dried. Making these helps to strengthen our fingers and the development of our fine motor skills. This month we are supporting our new children with settling in and the routines of nursery.
