Classroom News

Hope everyone had a great Easter break! Primary 5/6 really enjoyed all of our exciting learning and activities we took part in last term. We are looking forward to a busy Summer term!

Literacv

This term reading skills will be developed through the use of our Guided Reading books in class and our Accelerated Reading books - which will continue to be read at home and brought to school. We will be reading 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' by Roald Dahl as our class novel. In writing we will be focussing on continuing to develop our descriptive writing and we will be learning to write narrative stories. We will continue to focus on independently improving our writing. We will also be delivering presentations this term based around our class novel, global citizenship and enterprising learning.

We will be working on our Spanish language skills this term focussing on numbers to 30 and researching Spanish celebrations.

Numeracy

In numeracy this term, p5/6 will be focussing on fractions and percentages, area and perimeter, and volume and weight. We will be linking our numeracy skills to our life skills and everyday contexts, and using this to work on our problem solving. In mental maths we will be continuing with our strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Please encourage your child to access Sumdog at home to help with their numeracy development and ask them about their new learning.

Health and Wellbeing

Our Shanarri focus for this term is <u>ACTIVE</u> – Making good choices and promoting a healthy lifestyle.

In P.E with Mr Sharp on Mondays, we will be focussing on developing our athletics skills and working on our striking and fielding games skills. On Friday's with Miss Simpson we will be working on our team-based game skills, looking at leadership, communication and resilience skills.
