I can talk about the signs I see around me

I can recognise sign that I know (sign chart on A frame)

I can find my name card and talk about the outdoor clothing sign on the door to outside

I can find numbers and words in the environment around me (inside, outside and community walks)

I can talk about familiar signs, symbols, letters and number that are important to me (my house number/name, road crossing sign, happy emoji)

I can look at a nursery walk map, talk about and follow the pictures

I can talk about how signs and symbols help me

I can say how different weather makes me feel
