Other Curricular Areas

Within Digital Literacy we will be will be working on our coding skills using Scratch. We will continue using our research skills to obtain information about a variety of topics. Internet safety and cyber resilience will continue to be discussed throughout the term.

In IDL we will be having a Science focus. We will be working with Glasgow Science Centre to look at our solar system.

In Music and Drama all P5 and 6 pupils will be taking part in a Christmas show. More details of roles, scripts, songs, costumes and show tickets will follow.







<u>Literacy</u>

During work in Literacy the children will engage with group reading books and their AR books. Please try to encourage your child to read at home, and if possible discuss with them the book they are reading. Group reading books should be brought home and read each week. These will be used in class to complete activities so it is important that these books should be returned to school each week. Weekly spelling activities will continue and the children should continue to practise their lists, which will be posted each week on our class Teams page.

In written work we will be looking at exposition and response texts.

In French, we will be continuing to revise numbers as as learning about hobbies and pets.

Maths and Numeracy

This term we will focus on addition and subtraction strategies, with a focus on money, and the children will continue with weekly mental agility and number talks. Multiplication continues to be an on-going focus and we welcome support with practising times tables at home. We will continue to use Sumdog both at home and at school to aid our learning in Maths and Numeracy. We will also focus on 2D and 3D shape as well as area.

Health and Wellbeing (H&WB)

In PE we will be focussing on developing skills in gymnastics, dance and rebound games. Through our Wellbeing focus this term we will be learning how to assess and manage risk within school, whilst on trips and online. We will also be learning about food and health and the different nutritional needs we have as we grow.
