## Wider Achievements

## Literacy

During work in Literacy, we will be developing our writing skills through looking at different forms of poetry and then creating our own poems. We will also be looking at Scots dialect and using it in our writing.

In reading we will be studying a class novel and looking at different styles of writing. The children will continue to develop their comprehension skills through their group texts which are sent home to read for homework every week.

The children will be given new spelling words on a Tuesday, and they should work on these in class and at home throughout the week.

Within modern languages we will focus on French where we will learn how to talk about foods we like/dislike. We will also link our knowledge of numbers to telling the time in French

## Maths and Numeracy

Our work in numeracy this term will focus on completing calculations involving the four number processes and applying this to problem solving activities. We will look at solving algebraic equations and applying the correct order of operations (BODMAS).

In Maths with Mrs Sloan we will be learning about complementary & supplementary angles. We will also be interpreting maps or plans with simple scales e.g. 1cm to 2km. We will continue to develop our mental maths and problem-solving skills through weekly challenges.

## Homework

Homework will be issued electronically on our class Teams page.

- Spelling – new spelling lists will be issued on a Tuesday.
- Numeracy – children will be set a maths challenge every second week.
- Reading – your child will bring home a book where they have been set reading homework. Children should aim to read for a minimum of 20 minutes each night.

## Health and Wellbeing (H&WB)

In PE this term we will be working on possession games including hockey and badminton. P.E will be on a Monday and a Tuesday.

P7 will also be looking at ways in which the media tries to influence us and how to respond to an emergency situation.

## Other Curricular Areas

Within Digital Literacy we will be developing our skills when using technologies across different curricular areas including art and music.

This term P7 have chosen to study the Viking Invasion of Scotland and will look at the Scottish landscape.

Within Expressive Arts we will be using the visual elements to communicate ideas in response to a stimulus. We will also be creating patterns/designs and applying the principles of the printmaking process.
