Sun Cream

It is that time of the year when we can have all different weather in one day. As the sun is starting to show herself, **please put suncream on your child every morning** and if the weather needs, we will help your child put sun cream on again after lunch. **If you do not want us to use nursery suncream, please send in suncream for your child to be kept in nursery.** 8 hour sun cream can be applied at home and then no reapplying is needed. Applying sun cream to 56 children takes staff a long time which is why we ask you to apply sun cream in the morning to help us keep your child sun safe. **Please dress your child in long sleeved cotton tops, send in a sun hat and no strappy tops as bare shoulders burn very easily.** Thank you for your support 😊

Replenish bags regularly

Please check your child's draw stings bag regularly and if your child likes to play in the mud and outside, send in a few sets of spare clothes as they can go through them on a wet day.

A quick reminder to put your child's name in any clothing, coats, gloves, hats, shoes and wellies that come to nursery.
