Maths and Numeracy

Our work in numeracy this term will focus on Speed, distance and time calculations, working with money and bank accounts as well as consolidating work in number and applying different number processes.

In Maths with Mr Cannon, we will be looking at conversion in measurement and compass points and bearings.

Other Curricular Areas

Within Digital Literacy we will be developing our skills when coding and looking at different tools.

This term P7 will be looking at a variety of IDL concepts including light and sound and water and engineering.

Within Expressive Arts we will be concentrating on our P7 show!

Health and Wellbeing (H&WB)

In PE this term we will be working on athletics skills as well as participating in activities related to the sports champion award. P7 will also be looking at Relationships, Sexual Health and Parenthood. They will learn about fertilisation, pregnancy and the role of a parent.

Achievements

Please use the QR code for Book Creator to check-in with your child's learning and progress. These are continually updated throughout the year and it is a nice way to see what your child has been learning as well as seeing what they are proud of. We are always keen to hear about your child's wider achievements outside of school. Please encourage them to share these with us. They will find a master copy of the Wider Achievement Certificate in their Teams page. They should go to the General channel, and they will find it in the Files section at the top. Please download a copy of the master and edit this and then save their own version. They can also add this to the Wider Achievement section in their Book Creator Profile.



Homework

Homework will be issued electronically on our class Teams page.

- Spelling – new spelling lists will be issued on a Tuesday.
- Numeracy – children will be set a maths challenge every second week.
- Reading – your child will bring home their Accelerated Reading book where they have been set reading homework. Children should aim to read for a minimum of 20 minutes each night.

Literacy

During work in Literacy, we will be developing our writing skills through looking at personal and report writing. We will also be looking at distinguishing between fact and opinion and referencing our sources.

In reading we will be continuing to focus on our comprehension skills and different questioning techniques. Children will be focussing on their Accelerated Reading Book for homework each week.

The children will be given new spelling words on a Tuesday, and they should work on these in class and at home throughout the week.

Within modern languages we will focus on Spanish where we will use vocabulary associated with numbers, days and months and look at significant events associated with Spanish culture.
