Literacy

In reading we will be looking closely at setting, inferences about the author's point of view and looking at techniques used to convey character's feelings. Through our class novel and guided reading books we will continue to focus on all our comprehension skills. Please continue to encourage your child to engage with their Accelerated Reading and Guided reading books at home. Weekly spelling activities will continue and the children should continue to practise their lists, these are posted on Teams each Tuesday. In written work we will be looking at features of procedure, explanation and narrative writing. In grammar, we will continue to cover parts of speech as well as learning more about personification and metaphors. For our Modern Languages we will be looking at French culture as well as starting our Spanish block, focusing on basics such as dates, colours and the weather.



Other Curricular Areas

Within Digital Literacy we will be developing our skills to create spreadsheets, tables and graphs to present data. We will also continue to use our research skills linked to our IDL topic and we will develop our coding skills using a variety of software.

In Term 4 we will be taking part in another Glasgow Science Learning Lab with a focus on colour and light. Continuing with a science focus we will investigate how animals communicate and the functions of our sensory organs. As part of Technology, we will have a go at developing and designing our own product.

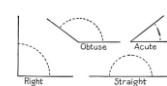
In Drama we will be exploring play scripts and how we can use voice and body language to convey and develop a character.

Part of our learning in Art will link to our learning in Technology as we learn about the different stages of the design process. We will also continue to create pieces of art inspired by other artists.



Maths and Numeracy

For Maths and Numeracy we will continue to reinforce mental maths strategies in our number talks and mental agility activities. The children will be linking multiplication and division facts and use this to help them as we learn about fractions and percentages. Data Handling will be a focus as we gather, sort and interpret data in different formats. We will also be learning about angles, coordinates and symmetry this term.



Health and Wellbeing (H&WB)

In PE we will be learning skills associated athletics and striking and field games. We will also be participating in sports day preparations.

Our Wellbeing focus this term is Healthy, where we will be focusing on the importance of mental wellbeing and developing our personal coping skills. We will also be learning about the importance of positive relationships and continuing our work on Zones of Regulation.
