Dear Parent/Carer,

I do hope you managed to enjoy the Christmas break and I take this opportunity to wish you all a Happy New Year.

As you are aware, unfortunately, from 6th January until the 1st February (at the earliest) the school will be closed to most pupils. We will be providing online learning for all pupils from Monday 11th January.

The online learning will be similar to last year. A learning grid will be posted on the school Blog <https://blogs.glowscotland.org.uk/dg/kirkcudbrightprimary/> on Friday of each week in order for parents to see the work set for the following week. The grid will also be posted in the files section of your child's Microsoft Team.

Teams can be accessed via Glow. <https://glow.rmunify.com/> Pupils will need their login that will start with the letters gw and their password.

From Glow they can click on the Teams tile and access their class team. In Teams pupils will be able to chat with their teacher and access the work.

Some people find it easier to download the Teams app, especially if using a mobile device.

When you log in using the app please use the Glow email but after the @ use **glow.sch.uk** instead of ea.dumgal.sch.uk e.g. gw17stevensdavid@glow.sc.uk



The grid will outline work for the week; however we strongly recommend that every child engages in ½ hour maths, ½ hour literacy and ½ hour health and wellbeing as a minimum per day. There will be many other activities for children to engage in on the grids. Your child's teacher may ask for particular work or task to be completed by a specified time. Teachers may also post daily challenges for your child.

It is vitally important that your child engages properly with the learning on line. Please help us help your child by ensuring tasks are completed and they engage with their teacher on Teams. Engagement on Teams is monitored by the software.

There are links to websites (for children) on the Blog that will further support learning.

We look forward to having all children back in school as soon as is safe. Until then please remember all staff are here to help and support children's learning however we can. Please get in touch either with the school or directly with your child's class teacher if you need any support.
