Art and Design -

- Naming and using different media e.g. paint, crayon...
- Drawing and painting a portrait / figure.
- Identifying basic colours and primary colours.
- Analysing / Recreating Local Artwork: Jim Sturgeon.
- Art and Design with Ms McLeman.

Music -

- Developing singing skills and rhythm, through simple songs, rhymes and games.

Literacy and English

Listening and Taking -
