I hope you all had an enjoyable October holiday. We had a busy but fun Halloween day on Tuesday this week and are now back into the usual daily routine.

It will be a busy term with lots on. Homework

All homework is due to be handed back in on Friday. On Friday we will have our spelling quiz as usual. Please send the homework bag every day. Reading books and/or words are heard most days in school so please send the homework bag in daily with your child. Please read books and words daily with your child as it has a huge impact on progress, helps to consolidate the language and helps with the next step in reading.

P3 will have PE on Tuesdays with me but please make sure your child has outdoor kit ready for every day as I will be taking the class outside as much as possible for PE. We will be using the wooded area for Outdoor Learning every alternate Friday as far as time allows unless it's particularly bad weather. I will tell the class the day before if we are going out. Please can you make sure your child has outdoor kit suitable for the weather, especially footwear and waterproof jacket.

Each day we will complete the Daily Mile so, as above, could you please make sure your child has a suitable warm, waterproof coat in case of cold and wet weather, and an extra layer for use in class as we keep it ventilated and cool.
