I hope you all had a restful and enjoyable October holiday. The focus overview for this term's topic, which is the **Romans** will be set out next Friday. We will continue to build on our previous learning from term 1. I hope that the overview will provide you with useful information about the learning which will be taking place in class this term. **Please talk to your child about the overview and ask them about their learning in class.**

This term, your child will receive a range of home learning tasks, which may include-

- Reading.
- Spelling - weekly - to be handed in on a Friday.
- Numeracy Launch Pads.
- Roman's Project - Due Friday 24th November.
- Children can also access Sumdog at home at any time to consolidate Numeracy and Maths skills. Log In details can be found at the front of the homework diary.

Homework will reinforce and extend the learning taking place in class. **Please ensure your child's homework is completed on time and is signed to show you have seen it. This would be greatly appreciated.**

P4 will continue to use Microsoft Teams. Photographs and examples of the children's work will be put on here so you can see what learning has been taking place at school. Please feel free to add any photographs on Teams to show your child's learning or achievements at home. Glow details can be found at the front of the homework diaries. Please log into Glow Scotland with your child at home to make sure it can be

accessed with no problems. The children have been learning to access this in school and exploring the features of Microsoft Teams within class lessons.

PE will take place on a Monday and Thursday. Please ensure they bring a suitable P.E. kit at the beginning of each week that can stay on their peg and all PE kits will be returned home on a Friday, when used during the week. We will also be taking part in the 'Daily Mile' outside every day so please ensure the children have appropriate footwear and a waterproof jacket. Please make sure they have an indoor pair of shoes to change into and a water bottle. Please make sure all clothing items are named.
