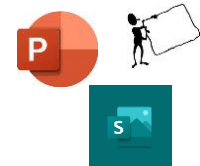
**DO** - Begin your preparation - fact gathering and note taking. Use the skills we have been developing in class.



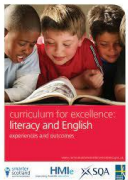
**WRITE** - Write what you are going to say to the audience in your presentation. You'll use this to read when you present your work. I encourage you to use cue cards to help.
