Dear Parent/Carer,

We're already in Term 2, and what a busy term it will be. Remember, I'm always happy to hear from you, please feel free to contact me regarding any concerns or queries that you may have, by appointment through the school office or - my preferred contact method - by emailing me using the email address above.

This term our topic will focus on Natural Disasters. Please see the curriculum overview for more details. Pupils will be given details of a Personal Research Topic to complete on this subject; they should prepare to share their finding, as a talk to the class, week beginning 11/12/23 - any support and encouragement you can offer your child would be much appreciated.

Pupils will conclude Safe Cycle training, from Bikeability, this term; and continue to take part in Outdoor Learning, in conjunction with Crichton Carbon Centre. Please ensure pupils come to school in appropriate outdoor clothing on those days, including sturdy shoes or wellies and a waterproof jacket. Waterproof trousers and a change of clothes may also be useful, if the weather is very poor. Pupils also have a trip to Edinburgh next Wednesday, 8th November to see Aladdin at the theatre. Pupils in P5, 6 and 7 have the opportunity to take part in After School Country Dancing this term and there will be a Christmas Fair, with Carol singing one evening. I look forward to seeing you at Parent Meetings which are over the next couple of weeks, where we can discuss how your child is getting on in school, and how you can support him / her at home.

Every Wednesday, Mrs Brown will take the class for a PE session. On Tuesdays we will have our class PE session. Please make sure that your child has their PE kit for those days - with names on all items, as well as names on their school uniform and jacket. We continue to make the most of any outdoor learning opportunities, so please also make sure your child has an outdoor jacket and water bottle every day.

Homework includes weekly spelling and continuing times table practise, additional homework will be noted in homework diaries. The weekly spelling list is included in our class Team – if your child is absent they must access their words there.
