Topic

Our topic this term will be a book study of 'George's Marvellous Medicine' (do not worry if your child knows the story, learning will focus on new skills and knowledge). Topic work will include the following subjects: Literacy, Health and Wellbeing, Art and Design, Technology, Maths and Science. Learning will include such things as:

- Developing a wide range of comprehension skills;
- Completing an author study;
- Developing skills within formative and personal writing;
 - Learning about personal safety;
 - Learning to recognise and manage feelings and emotions;
- Developing drawing skills such as using line and colour;
 - Measurement;
- Developing our understanding of liquid

Numeracy

Numeracy learning will focus on developing core number skills. This will include:
