Continuing from last term, focus will be on learning in Literacy, Numeracy and Health and Wellbeing which may result in occasional changes to the above timetable.

Topic

Our topic this term will focus on Time and Key Events. Topic work will include the following subjects: Literacy, Health and Wellbeing, Art and Design, Technology, Maths and Science.

Learning will include such things as:

- Developing a wide range of comprehension skills;
- Sequencing key events;
- Developing a Timeline;
- Developing skills within formative and personal writing;
 - Learning about growth and development;
- Developing skills of creating mood in our drawings through use of tone;
- Exploring Art through listening to pieces of music as a stimulus;
 - Time Durations;
- Seasons, months and days of the week;
- Developing our understanding of inherited characteristics in Science work.

R.M.E.

This term we will be studying key events such as Halloween, Guy Fawkes Night and Christmas linked to the Christian faith. We will compare how different religions celebrate Christmas.



Numeracy

Numeracy learning will continue to focus on developing core number skills. This will include:

- Counting
- The 4 number processes (addition, subtraction, division and multiplication).
- Time
- Symmetry

Maths will link with topic and develop knowledge in aspects of using time.



Reading: we will continue to use the Oxford Reading Tree/Sound Start schemes to develop our fluency in reading. This term we will also be working on identifying fact and opinion in audio and written texts.

Handwriting: Letter/number accuracy and handwriting joins.

Writing: Poetry and functional writing linked to our topic.

Grammar: We will be following the Jolly Grammar Programme of study, developing our confidence and ability to create consistency and accurate writing (this will include sentence structure, transferring spelling and handwriting skills, using a range of punctuation etc).

Health and Wellbeing: Health and wellbeing will continue to be a big focus. We will work on, relationships with others, resilience and hygiene. We will also be looking at growth and development focusing on babies and considering how to look after a baby and in turn look after ourselves.
