CAPER

We will soon be starting CAPER on Wednesdays. CAPER is a great opportunity for Children and Parents to Enjoy Reading at home. Children will get to choose a book at nursery and bring it home to read with parents. Inside your child's red CAPER bag you will find a jotter where your child can mark their evaluation of the story. We ask you fill this out at home with the child once you have read the story and bring the book bag back in for the following Wednesday. Children who are not in on a Wednesday will still receive a CAPER book each week.

Snack

Snack is 50p per session, there is an honesty box in each playroom. If you have any suggestions for snack, please add them to our list in the foyer. We are always looking for new ideas of healthy and nutritious snacks. ☺

Gym times

This session's gym times for the nursery are on a Monday morning and a Thursday afternoon. We ask that children wear comfortable clothing on these days to allow them to participate in all of our gym activities.



Shoes/Wellies

Just a reminder that children are allowed to leave both indoor shoes and wellies at nursery. We ask that parents/carers put their child's name on their shoes to help prevent shoes getting lost or going missing.
