

Term 1 Plan P1, 2 and 7, August—October 2024 Topic: The Victorians / Toys from the Past



<u>Victorians / Toys from the Past</u> History focus

In this topic we will learn about Scotland in the time of Queen Victoria- how life, school and work differ from today. We will also learn about Toys from the past and how they have changed over time. We will visit Dalbeattie Museum at the start of the term to look at lots of local artefacts from over 100 years ago, up until today. P1/2 pupils will also lead the learning in this topic through play.

P7 will carry out more research of the topic using books and the internet.

Literacy

Listening & Talking

We will continue to develop listening skills as part of a quality audience. We will share thoughts in group/class discussions. We will share and discuss our favourite toys.

We will work on weekly listening assessments.

Reading

We will continue to read for pleasure in our school and class library. We will work on reading and comprehension skills at school and at home with core reading books. We will listen to / read and enjoy some stories that were told to children in the Victorian times (Beatrix Potter tales, Alice in Wonderland etc.) P1/2 will continue to learn common words and ORT words by sight.

Writing/Grammar

We will all develop our Recount writing, and associated grammar, on a variety of familiar subjects e.g. ourselves, animals and places. (Mondays with Auchencairn) We will work on handwriting to ensure that our work is neat and legible for others to read. We will use technology to support our writing or for redrafting work.

Spelling

P7 Core Spelling programme

We will continue to remember, understand and apply spelling rules and strategies in weekly class activities.

We will complete Spelling homework to consolidate, 2 tasks per week.

P1-2 Phonics

We will continue to recognise and form letters of the alphabet and the sounds they make, blend sounds to make /write words.



Numeracy and Maths

All groups will be working at their own pace and level

Number- Place Value, Addition and Subtraction

- P7 will complete daily independent mental maths activities to revise and consolidate all aspects of numeracy and maths.
- We will all continue looking at Numbers and Place Value at our own levels.
- All groups will work on addition and subtraction.
- All pupils will work on mental maths skills and applying their knowledge in problems and games (Miss Nichol—Fridays)

<u>Data Handling (Mondays in</u> Auchencairn)

- All groups will work on collecting and analysing data at their own levels.
- We will do paired and group tasks to carry out surveys and share findings.
