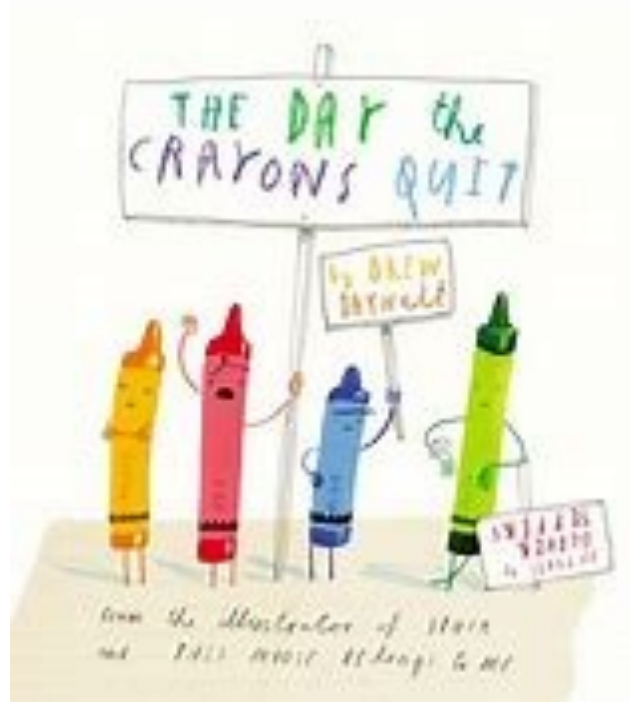


You should read it because:

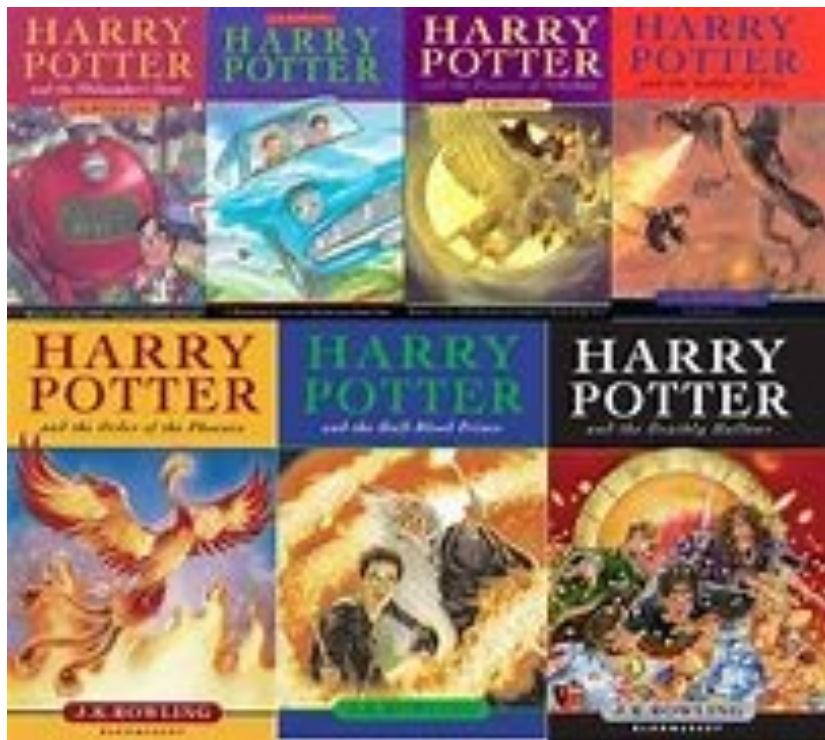
### The Day the Crayons Quit

Our teacher read the story and we did lots of activities in class. The story was funny and the crayons all had different ideas. We should have a colour day at school.

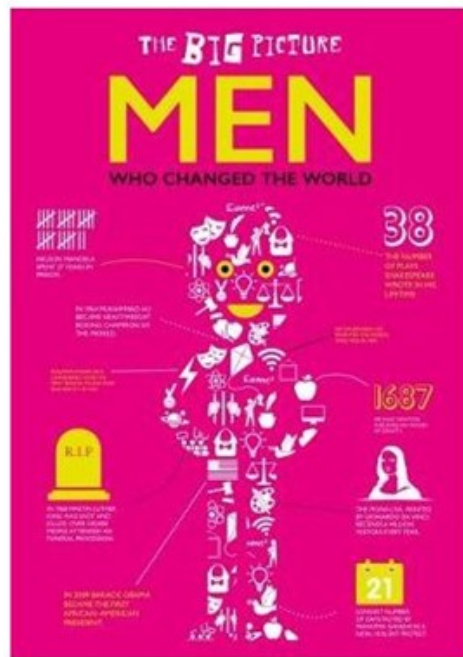
# P4 Recommends: Harry Potter Books

# P5K Recommends: Men Who Changed the World



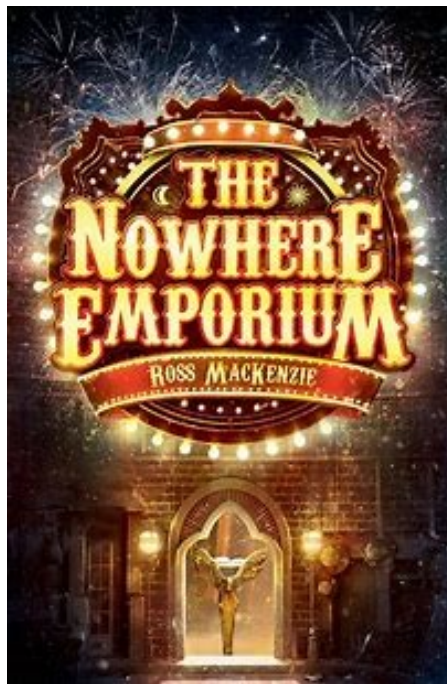
You should read it because:

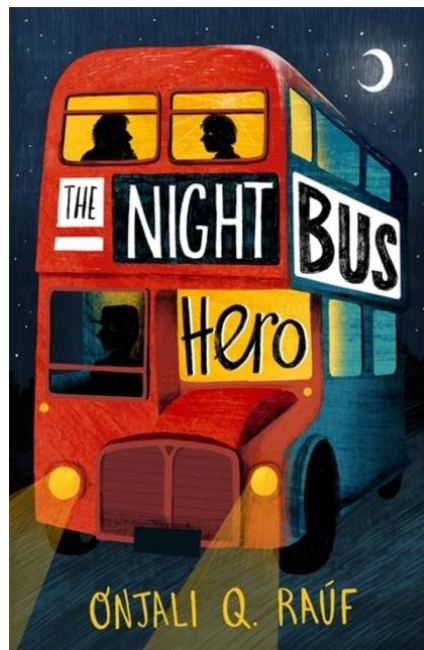
You should read it because:

You should read it because:

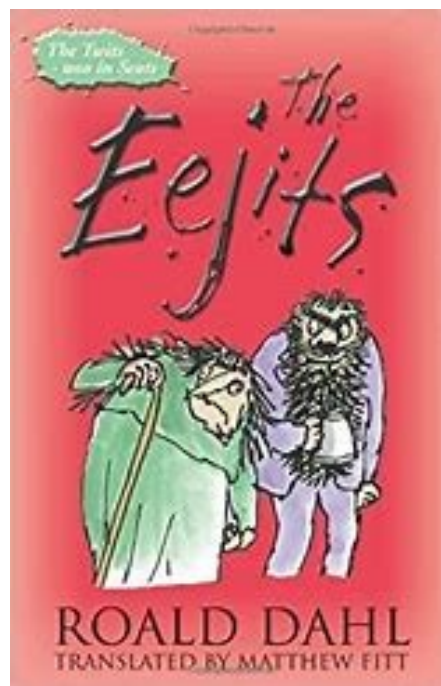
The story is about a bully, or is he a bully? What does he need to change.
