Personal Plans

Each child in nursery has their own personal care plan which contains the child's personal details, emergency contacts, medical issues, family information and any other information regarding your



child's needs whilst at nursery. We set up a personal plan when each child starts at nursery and then review these every 6 months, or when required.

Your child's key worker will arrange an appointment with yourself for a convenient time. This will either be face-to-face or over the phone, whichever suits you best. You will be asked for a suitable time when you drop off/pick up your child over the next few days if you have not already done so.



All About Me

Each child has been issued with an 'All About Me' booklet for their first year. If your child was with us last year, they will receive a 'More About Me' booklet, as a lot of things can change in the space of a year! We use these to help plan for interests, activities and snacks, as well as using them to find out more about your child and their life at home. We ask that you complete these and return as soon as possible please.

'All About Me' will also be the focus for learning over the next couple of weeks as the children settle within nursery. We will be drawing attention to our differences and similarities, what makes us individuals and who we have in our families.

Lunches

Since reopening in August, we have adapted our lunch routine to make this more child-led and to provide further opportunities to increase children's independence. To increase this further, we will be introducing 'on the day' ordering for our 3-5s, instead of the advance ordering system previously used. This means that you and your child can now decide what they would like for lunch on a day-by-day basis. To support this, your child will have two photographs beside their name tag in the main reception. You can take these and place their photographs on the lunch option sheets displayed in the reception area before you enter the main nursery room to make their selection. A member of staff will be on hand to assist you. This will be coming in to effect on 12/9/22.

If your child does not always have a school meal, please keep a copy of the lunch menu handy (you can access this via the Dumfries & Galloway Council website) to ensure that they bring their packed lunch on the relevant days.

Online Learning Journals

We realise how important it is to keep you, as parents, as up to date with your child's development as possible. We utilise an online learning journal system, where you can access observations of your child



and their next steps. All families should have now have received a Learning Journal permission form and we ask that these are completed and returned as soon as possible. At present, our nursery iPads have been taken away for updating, so uploads on to

Learning Journals may be a bit slower than usual due to using cameras and computers so please bear with us.

Outdoor Play



At Rephad Nursery, we have a large emphasis on outdoor play. Our outdoor area is open for the majority of the session and children are able to free-flow between indoors and outdoors as they wish. With Autumn around the corner, we ask parents to ensure that their child has their own pair of wellies which can be kept in nursery in order to keep their feet dry. Children have access to waterproof clothing, which

were purchased through fundraising monies. Although we do have some sets of wellies in nursery, unfortunately we do not have enough for each child or a large variety of sizes. Thank you in advance.

Snack

In nursery, snack operates on a rolling rota. Presently, we are continuing with last session's rota but aim to update this during term 1 to reflect the tastes of our current children.

Please find a copy of the current snack rota below. Please note, week commencing 5/9 will be week 2. Snack for the week, as well as any allergens, can be found on the parent's board within main

reception. We also provide an afternoon snack of fruit/veg and have milk/water on offer for the children to drink, in line with the Scottish Government's Milk & Healthy Snack Scheme.


