Dear Parent / Carer,

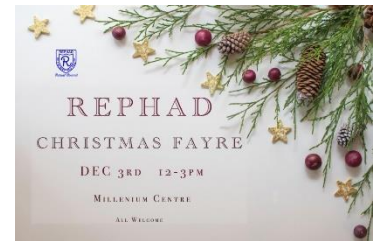
